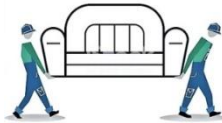

## How to Avoid Money Problems - Tip #4



Tip # 4 is to build a fund for emergencies - e.g., expenses from a car accident. Having an E-fund means you won't have to dip into your other savings.
