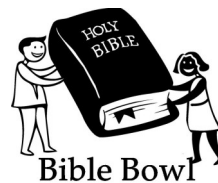

The ornate cross in the Narthex also displays this progress.

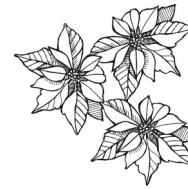
