VBS is getting closer and we have a list of supplies needed to decorate our set and create some hands-on materials. Needed are:

- two 4X8 foot pegboards
- 2" PVC pipe - 50 feet or we will take scrap pieces no shorter than 12" (2 pieces) or 30" or longer (8 pieces)
- 8 elbow fittings for 2" PVC pipes
- PVC elbows 3/4" (8 pieces) and 2" elbows (6 pieces)
- PVC pipe 3/4" - 3 or more feet or scrap pieces 10" or more
- clear vinyl tubing 1" OD and 3/4" ID - 3 feet or more, or scraps of 10" or more
- Bubble wrap

Also, start saving **vegetable** tin cans (soup cans are too narrow) - we need 50. Also, plastic caps from milk containers. We also need old pie tins, old metal lids from pots, old pans, pots, and metal graters. Start saving boxes of all sizes with lids that can be taped shut - bigger than one foot.

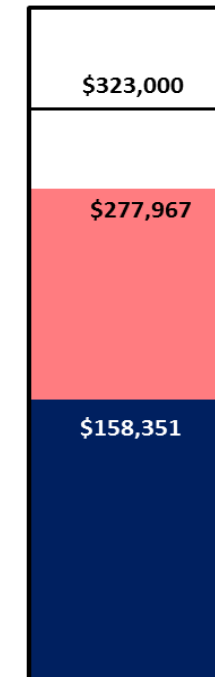

The Trinity Radio Club needs your help in multiple ways. First, we are still looking for people to help us out in the radio room with recording and streaming our services. Our other need is monetary. We'll be coming up on our renewal for 2017-2018 with KDHL in September. Our broadcasts cost us \$170 per service to put on the radio. For all of our services (every Sunday plus mid-week Advent and Lent and Maundy Thursday and Good Friday as well as Christmas Day and Christmas Eve), it cost us \$10,800 for this period (contracts run October 1 - September 30). We need your help to continue these services on KDHL. We have less than half of the fund necessary to cover the next contract period. Any gifts would be appreciated so we can continue this ministry.

April 2018 will be our 70th anniversary. We thank you for your continued support of the Radio Club as we further the ministry of Trinity!
