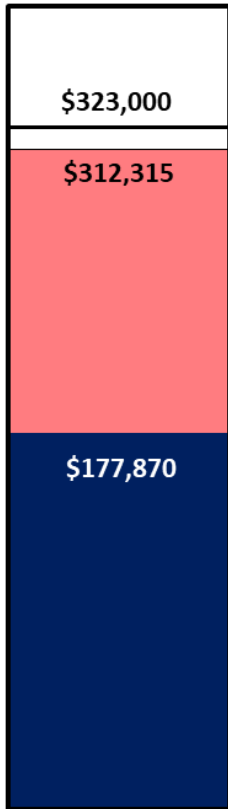

The Trinity Radio Club needs your help in multiple ways. First, we are still looking for people to help us out in the radio room with recording and streaming our services. Our other need is monetary. We'll be coming up on our renewal for 2017-2018 with KDHL in September. Our broadcasts cost us \$170 per service to put on the radio. For all of our services (every Sunday plus mid-week Advent and Lent and Maundy Thursday and Good Friday as well as Christmas Day and Christmas Eve), it cost us \$10,800 for this period (contracts run October 1 - September 30). We need your help to continue these services on KDHL. We have less than half of the funds necessary to cover the next contract period. Any gifts would be appreciated so we can continue this ministry.

April 2018 will be our 70th anniversary. We thank you for your continued support of the Radio Club as we further the ministry of Trinity!

**Romans 8:18-25**

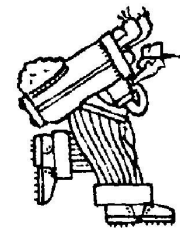
