Trinity Scholarships Given to Trinity Families



Again this year, the Trinity Scholarship money that was built up over the past six to eight months was given to Trinity families that have children in FLS in the form of tuition reductions. This money was donated by individual Trinity members and by the Trinity Pie-makers for the purpose of making it easier for Trinity families to afford to send their kids to FLS and to show our appreciation for their support of our school.

This year, \$5,000 was distributed to five Trinity families who could use financial help for the tuition (as determined by the TADS process), and \$5,000 from the Trinity Pie-makers was distributed to all Trinity families with kids in FLS on an equal basis at the rate of \$200 per child. In the 2018-2019 school year, 14 Trinity families with 25 children are enrolled in FLS.

All of these distributions were given directly to FLS, which were then deducted from the families' tuition statements. Thanks to all who gave to this fund during 2018 and to the Trinity Pie-makers for your generosity and support to our congregation and our school.
