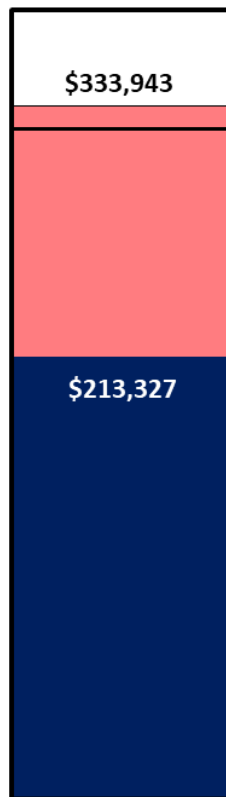


IT'S ALL ABOUT GRACE" New Office Addition Fundraiser
