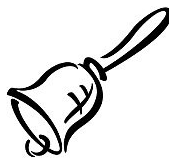
## HUMAN CARE

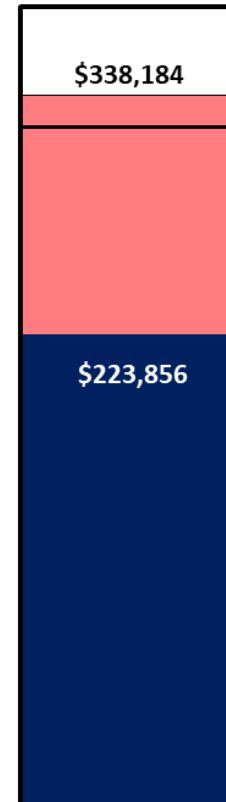
