

Sunday, January 10, 2021
8:00 AM

The Sacrament Of The Altar will be celebrated at the 8:00 AM service. Anyone who is not yet instructed, in doubt or holds a differing confession and yet desires to receive the Sacrament is asked first to speak with a Pastor, Elder or Worship Assistant.

INVOCATION

- P** In the name of the Father and of the ✠ Son and of the Holy Spirit.
C Amen.

- P** Let us now say together our memory verse.
C **Trust in the Lord with all your heart, and do not lean on your own understanding. (Proverbs 3:5)**

- P** Our help is in the name of the Lord,
C **who made heaven and earth.**

CONFESSION AND FORGIVENESS OF SINS

- P** Brothers and sisters in Christ, if we say we have no sin, we deceive ourselves, and the truth is not in us.
C **But if we confess our sins, God, who is faithful and just, will forgive our sins and cleanse us from all unrighteousness.** *1 John 1:8,9*

- P** Let us then confess our sins to God our Father...
C **Most merciful God, we confess that we are sinful and unclean. We have sinned against You and each other by what we think, what we say, and what we do and do not do. We have not loved You with our whole heart; we have not loved our neighbor as ourselves. We deserve only punishment for our sins.**

(A time for silent confession of sins)

P For the sake of Your Son, Jesus Christ, who gave His life that we would live,
C **Look upon us with mercy and forgive us our sins. Change us and make us new. Amen.**

P People of God, I have good news for you! God has heard your pleas for mercy and given you His Son, Jesus Christ, to die for you and to rise to bring you life. Therefore, as a called and ordained servant of my Lord Jesus Christ and by His authority, I forgive you all your sins. In the name of God, the Father, Son and Holy Spirit.

C **Amen**

SALUTATION

P The Lord be with you.

C **And also with you.**

COLLECT OF THE DAY

P Let us pray together...

C **Lord Jesus, You are our Good Shepherd. You have protected us from our enemies of sin, death, and the power of the devil. Continue to guide, protect, and shepherd us by Your Word, and help us to do the same with one another as we share our lives together; in Your Name we pray this. Amen**

FIRST READING

³¹When the words that David spoke were heard, they repeated them before Saul, and he sent for him. ³²And David said to Saul, "Let no man's heart fail because of him. Your servant will go and fight with this Philistine." ³³And Saul said to David, "You are not able to go against this Philistine to fight with him, for you are but a youth, and he has been a man of war from his youth." ³⁴But David said to Saul, "Your servant used to keep sheep for his father. And when there came a lion, or a bear, and took a lamb from the flock, ³⁵I went after him and struck him and delivered it out of his mouth. And if

he arose against me, I caught him by his beard and struck him and killed him.

³⁶Your servant has struck down both lions and bears, and this uncircumcised Philistine shall be like one of them, for he has defied the armies of the living God."
