Thoughts on Our Memory Verse

In Ephesians 4:22-24 (The memory verse, 24, is the end of the sentence.), Paul says that we are “taught in Christ”:

- “²²... to put off your old self, which belongs to your former manner of life and is corrupt through deceitful desires,
- ²³ and to be renewed in the spirit of your minds,
- ²⁴ and to put on the new self, created after the likeness of God in true righteousness and holiness.”

It’s like taking off dirty, stinky clothes, getting into a hot, soapy shower, and then putting on clean, fresh-smelling clothes. Aah, that feels so good.

But it isn’t just good; it’s perfection. Note that the new self is “created after the likeness of God in true righteousness and holiness.”

That reminds me of Genesis 1:26: “Then God said, “Let us make man in our image, after our likeness.” Our new self puts us back to the way God intended man to be at our creation!

Now that we’re dressed in our clean clothes, let’s put on the armor of God (Ephesians 6:11) to protect them, and get to work. And be sure to burn those filthy rags! You do not want to go back to your old ways.

Thanks be to the Father for the perfect plan. Thanks be to the Son for the perfect sacrifice. Thanks be to the Spirit for working faith in us, making us truly righteous (right with God), and renewing our minds to live in a way that can be called truly holy. Amen.
