Thoughts on Our Memory Verse



"The meek shall obtain fresh joy in the Lord, and the poor among mankind shall exult in the Holy One of Israel."

(Isaiah 29:19)

In our Ephesians focus, we finish chapter 5 and head into chapter 6. These passages are all about how we live in relationship with one another in light of the new life in Christ. The uniting verse in all these relationships is Ephesians 5:21 where we are told to submit to one another out of reverence for Jesus.

Another word for submission is meekness. To submit to one another means that we are meek. We live in a world of dominance and taking advantage of one another. "As long as I get mine, I don't care what happens to anyone else," would not be strange for us to hear. But humble submission in meekness is what God calls us to do. The world will mock us for it, but as we submit to one another out of reverence for Jesus, we know that our meekness will provide us with the true glory. As Jesus himself says in Matthew 5:5, "Blessed are the meek, for they shall inherit the earth."



Faribault Lutheran School


The first day of FLS is Tuesday, August 31. Opening Chapel at 9:00 a.m. Remember to keep the staff and students of FLS in your prayers!
