Thoughts on Our Memory Verse

Ephesians 6:11 - *Put on the whole armor of God, that you may be able to stand against the schemes of the devil.*

The idea of spiritual warfare can be daunting. God's whole armor is described in verses 14-17. Briefly, it consists of truth, righteousness, readiness from the gospel of peace, faith, and salvation for defense. The only weapon we have is the Spirit ("the word of God"). Outfitted for battle, we are to pray at all times in the Spirit (verse 18).

Luther said, "Where God built a church, there the Devil would also build a chapel." So we know that the more we try to do for the kingdom, the more the devil will attack us. But here we find that God has given us what we need to protect ourselves. It is also heartening to remember that, as C. S. Lewis said, "Satan ... is the opposite, not of God, but of Michael." He is not an equal, but evil, force; he is not all-powerful, all-knowing, or all-anything-else.

Lewis also said, "He (the devil) always sends errors into the world in pairs - pairs of opposites. And he always encourages us to spend a lot of time thinking which is the worse. ... He relies on your extra dislike of the one error to draw you gradually into the opposite one. But do not let us be fooled. We have to keep our eyes on the goal and go straight through between both errors."

The devil would like us to believe everything is an either/or proposition. But choosing the lesser of two evils is still choosing evil. There is always a third choice.

Deliver us from evil. Amen.

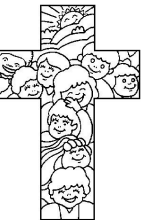

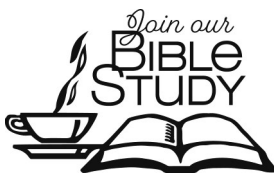
