Thoughts on Our Memory Verse

1 Thessalonians 5:11 - *Therefore encourage one another and build one another up, just as you are doing.*

I've often wondered why a church needs a mission statement other than the one given by Jesus in Matthew 28:19-20a. We're to go, make disciples, baptize them and teach them. But Trinity's new mission statement, "Connect, Grow, Go," recognizes that there is a process in preparing to be sent.

Jesus called his disciples to connect them first to himself. That is also the foremost connection we need. Nothing else matters if we are not saved by faith. But Jesus does not want Christian hermits. We have a duty to connect with each other in a congregation.

This memory verse reminds me of migrating geese. Scientists say that geese fly in a "V" formation, because it saves energy. Each goose gets a little lift from the goose in front of it. A flock has a 70% greater range than a goose flying solo! No one goose is the leader for long. When he gets tired, he drops back and another goose moves up to the front.

And all the honking? It is thought that it is the flock encouraging the leader to keep going, cheering him on to keep up speed. "Go, Bob! You can do it!"

In the Trinity flock, we need to keep honking at each other. See verses 12-15 for Paul's specific instructions on how to do that.

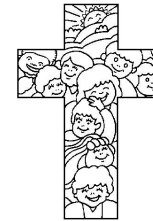
