Thoughts on Our Memory Verse

Amos 5:14 "Seek good, and not evil, that you may live; and so the Lord, the God of hosts, will be with you, as you have said."

I love The Simpsons. A great episode is where Bart gets famous for saying, "I didn't do it." It becomes his catchphrase and launches him into stardom. While it's a funny show, it's something we all say to pass the blame and guilt away from ourselves to something or someone else. But the truth is that we do it. We read in Romans 3:23, "for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God." This sin leads to impurity, a concept introduced in Leviticus. Purity is the state of being we must be in so that we might stand in God's presence. Purity is also known as holiness. However, like Israel failed to remain in their purified state, we continue to fall into impure things as well.

But in Hebrews 10, we are reminded of Christ and our baptisms in him. Since Jesus fulfilled the law and the requirements for purity on our behalf through his death and resurrection and we have been baptized into him and his work, and therefore his purity, we now can confidently stand before our God in his presence.

But as for now, living as God's purified people, we live with a purified heart that seeks good and not evil, seeks love and service. As we read in James 1, "Religion that is pure and undefiled before God the Father is this: to visit orphans and widows in their affliction, and to keep oneself unstained from the world." Our way of loving service and fleeing from sin is the good we seek to truly show, thereby showing how the Lord, the God of hosts, is with us and how he has restored us to be his people. Our good shows God's goodness. Remember what Jesus says in Matthew 15:11, "it is not what goes into the mouth that defiles a person, but what comes out of the mouth; this defiles a person." What comes out of us shows the world who we belong to.

LWML meeting October 21, 1:00 p.m. Bible study led by one of our pastors. Ellen Blume, serving. Everyone welcome!

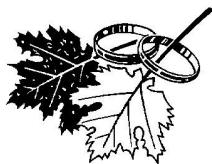
FELLOWSHIP
