Thoughts on Our Memory Verse

So Jesus said to the Jews who had believed in him, "If you abide in my word, you are truly my disciples, and you will know the truth, and the truth will set you free." John 8:31-32

To abide in Jesus' word means to live with faith in the **all** of his teachings. In John 8, we see Jesus emphasize his oneness with God the Father. This uniquely qualifies him to be the Messiah. Jesus said, "... unless you believe that I am he, you will die in your sins." (v24b) This truth is the Gospel: faith in Jesus sets us free from the Law's condemnation.

These new believers showed by their questioning (v33-57) that they certainly did not believe **all** that Jesus said. They could not let go of their belief that being descendants of Abraham gave them their worth.

But the word of God is not a menu where we can just pick what we like. Ignoring what we don't like can ultimately lead us to reject Christ himself, as it did here. When Jesus asserted his deity, and thus his superiority over Abraham, with, "Before Abraham was born, I am," "they picked up stones to stone him." (v58b-59) Shortest conversions of all time! Jesus busted them out of prison, and they ran right back in the front gate!

The truth (Gospel) has set us free. Let's not put our shackles of the Law back on, thinking that something we can do (or not do) will affect our salvation in any way. Our mission is to break other prisoners out of that jail.
