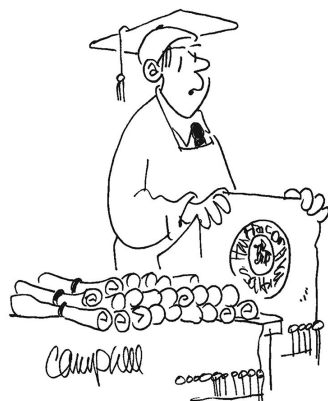

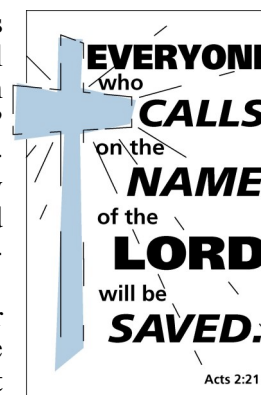
Thoughts on Our Memory Verse

Acts 2:21, "And it shall come to pass that everyone who calls upon the name of the Lord shall be saved."

Paul says in Romans 10:14, "How then will they call on him in whom they have not believed? And how are they to believe in him of whom they have never heard? And how are they to hear without someone preaching?"

At Pentecost, Peter preaches to the people gathered and we hear that his words strike their hearts. There is power in our proclamation of the Law and Gospel. The Holy Spirit fell on the people at Pentecost and they began to preach. The Spirit has fallen on the baptized, so now we preach. You preach and proclaim the problem of sin and death and the salvation found in Jesus. What started at Pentecost has not ended so be bold as those who preached at Pentecost. God will work through your words as well to strike the hearts of people so they will be led to Him and call on Him to be saved.
