Pastor Larry Wesolik Will Serve as Vacancy Pastor



“Pastor W.” will be serving Trinity while we wait to receive our next fulltime Pastor. Last Monday we elected to call Pastor Derek Broten from Lakeville, Minnesota. As we wait, Pastor Wesolik will serve as a part time Vacancy Pastor.

Pastor W. will be preaching at all services starting on the 19th of November. He will lead Sunday Adult Bible Classes on the Sundays he preaches. He will also cover Confirmation instruction starting on the 7th of December. Other pastoral duties are included as are allowed by his part time position. Pastor W. will be at Trinity on most Wednesday mornings at 9:30 a.m.

Pastor W. lives in Lakeville, Minnesota. He has had considerable years of experience. He has served full time in four separate states. Subsequent to retirement, he has served in places as diverse as McAllen, Texas, and West St. Paul, Minnesota. Overall, he has served in 15 different churches. He has most often served parishes with Christian Day Schools.

Pastor is married to Faith Ovrebo-Wesolik. Faith acquired her P.H.D. in Education and has

worked as a Professor of Education in Illinois and Ohio. The Lord has blessed their marriage with two children. Their son, Christopher, lives in Merrillville, Indiana. Their daughter, Aimee, is married and lives in Sioux Falls, South Dakota.

Bible Classes will start on the 20th of November where pastor will focus on a more thorough revelation of his history and ministries, and on mutual sharing with those in attendance. The following Sundays will feature an exploration of favorite readings from the Old Testament book of Isaiah.
