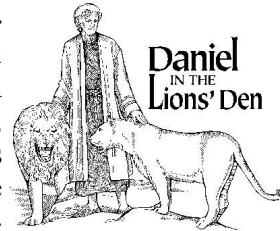

Thoughts on Luke 9:23

"And he said to all, "If anyone would come after me, let him deny himself and take up his cross daily and follow me."

When someone has a long-lasting problem or ailment, we may hear them say, "That's my cross to bear." But when Jesus took up *his* cross, he wasn't bearing his own troubles; he was picking up ours. He took the sins of everyone throughout time onto his own shoulders. He dragged them out of town and up a hill and was nailed to them.

What does it mean to deny ourselves? Paul, in Philippians 2:3-8, says it best: *"Do nothing from selfish ambition or conceit, but in humility count others more significant than yourselves. Let each of you look not only to his own interests, but also to the interests of others. Have this mind among yourselves, which is yours in Christ Jesus, who, though he was in the form of God, did not count equality with God a thing to be grasped, but emptied himself by taking the form of a servant, being born in the likeness of men. And being found in human form, he humbled himself by becoming obedient to the point of death, even death on a cross."*

Jesus set the example. When the Son, the Second Person of the God-Trinity, took human form and came to live on earth, he also gave up the independent use of his God-hood and submitted to the Father's will to save us all.

Jesus calls us to likewise replace our own desires and goals with God's will. And he told us that our cross is the mission to go and make disciples, baptizing them and teaching them.

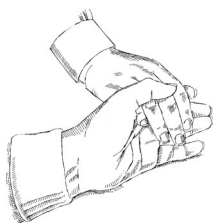
