Thoughts on Hebrews 4:16

Let us
therefore
come boldly
unto the
throne of grace.

HEBREWS 4:16, KJV

"Let us then with confidence
draw near to the throne of grace,
that we may receive mercy and
find grace to help in time of
need."

Have you ever been in a situa-
tion where you felt really out of
place and thought maybe you
shouldn't be there at all? Maybe
you went to a party and realized
that you didn't know anyone or
that everyone else was dressed up while you were
wearing jeans.

I recently found myself staying in a hotel that
was much fancier than what I usually stay at.
There was a valet, a Bluetooth icon in the middle
of the bathroom mirror, and lighting under the
bed! The lobby was huge and quite elegant. I felt
uneasy whenever I had to ask a question at the
front desk. I bet I would have felt a lot more com-
fortable if the owner's son had escorted me in . . .

The writer of Hebrews tells us that we can enter
the very throne-room of God with that kind of as-
surance, and we will receive mercy and grace.
Verse 15 says that this is because Jesus, our high
priest, experienced all kinds temptation and can
therefore sympathize with our struggles.

So, in that context, our "time of need" refers to
when we need understanding and help in resisting
temptation. But I am sure it holds true for all of
our needs.

We can feel comfortable, even bold, in bringing
our requests to God, because Jesus escorts us,
saying, "They're with me, Dad."

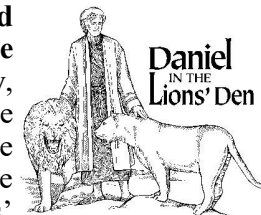
