Thoughts on Romans 3:23 by Kristin Sellentine

"For all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God."

When we were kids, my brother would yell, "Last one to the house is a rotten egg!" and start running. After losing most times, I figured out to yell, "Not included!" at his disappearing backside. And that undid the curse. Eventually I would yell, "Not included for the rest of my life!" at whatever challenge my brother threw out. And he had no more power over me!

But when Paul says, "All," we don't get to say that we are not included. Our words do not undo the truth.

We all need a Savior, because, as Paul points out, the standard is God's glory, His goodness.

There is no use pointing out the people we are "better than." If there were a scale on which God was a 10 and Hitler was a 1, I suspect most of us would rate ourselves at a 7 or 8. Certainly, no less than a 5! The truth is that we are all a 1. Yup, we are all rubbing elbows with Hitler, Jeffrey Daumer, and child abusers. Next to us are Martin Luther, Mother Teresa, and all of the apostles.

On its face, this verse seems to be only one of condemnation, but there is hope when we realize we can't earn salvation. The burden for that was lifted off of us and taken on by Jesus. He alone did not sin and fall short of God's glory. He alone can say, "Not included for the rest of my life!"
