Please note that this is the budgetary needs, not the actual expenses. Actual expenses are depicted in the monthly graph.

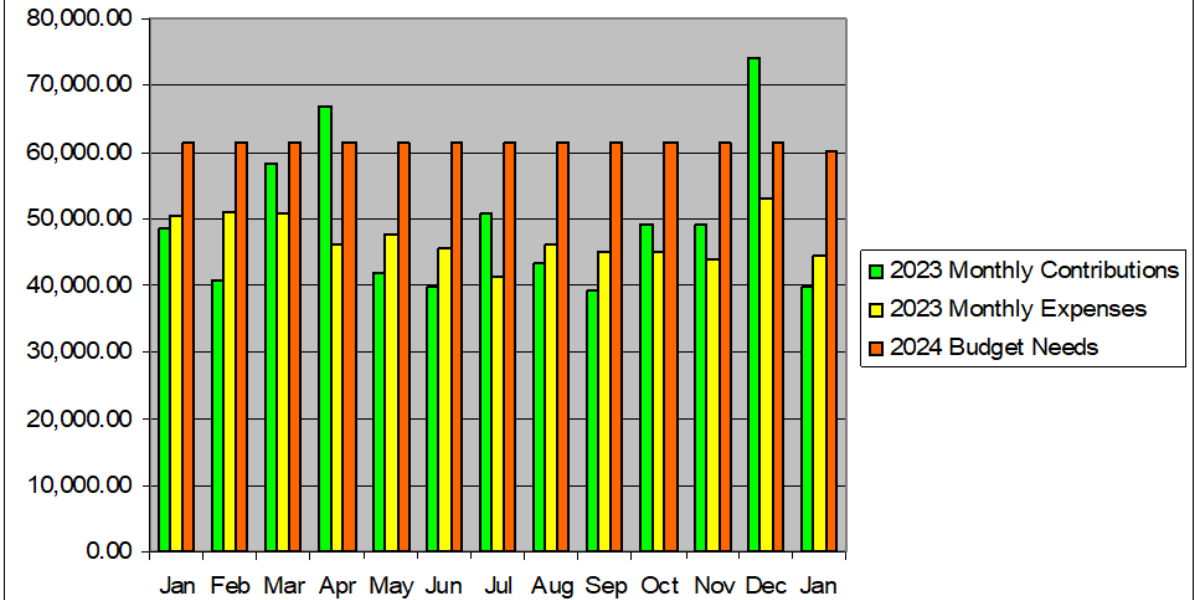
PASTOR'S SCHEDULE
