A RENEWED ASSAULT ON LIFE



The next legislative session is still two weeks away and yet a renewed assault on life has already begun. In a rarely used maneuver designed to push a controversial bill forward without the public being aware of it, the Minnesota House Health

Finance and Policy Committee has scheduled a PRE-session hearing to advance a bill (HF1930) to **legalize physician-assisted suicide** here in Minnesota.

We thank God for Rev. Peter Gueldner, who has accepted the Call to be Trinity's Intentional Interim Pastor.

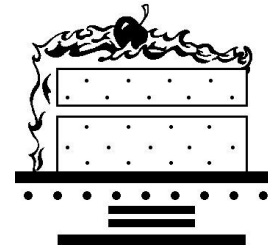
The Installation Service will be held on Saturday, February 3, 2024, at 5:30 p.m.
