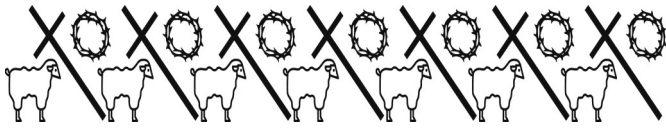
**HUMAN CARE**
