HUMAN CARE



A big "THANK YOU" to everyone who donated blood at Trinity on Friday, August 2. We collected 34 units. This was a little below our goal, but still a good turnout. We are very thankful for everyone who made the effort to donate life-saving blood!

The American Red Cross is experiencing an emergency blood shortage. Overall, the Red Cross national blood supply has fallen by more than 25% since July 1. There was a shortfall of more than 19,000 blood donations in July.



Blood product distributions to hospitals are outpacing the number of blood donations coming in, which is rapidly drawing down the blood supply. The Red Cross is working with hospitals around the clock to meet the blood needs of patients – but can't do it alone. **We need your help!**
