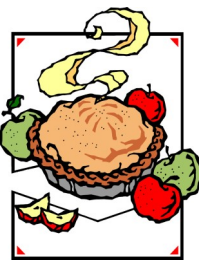


Trinity Pie Makers will offer pies for sale for Thanksgiving. The pies will be frozen and unbaked.

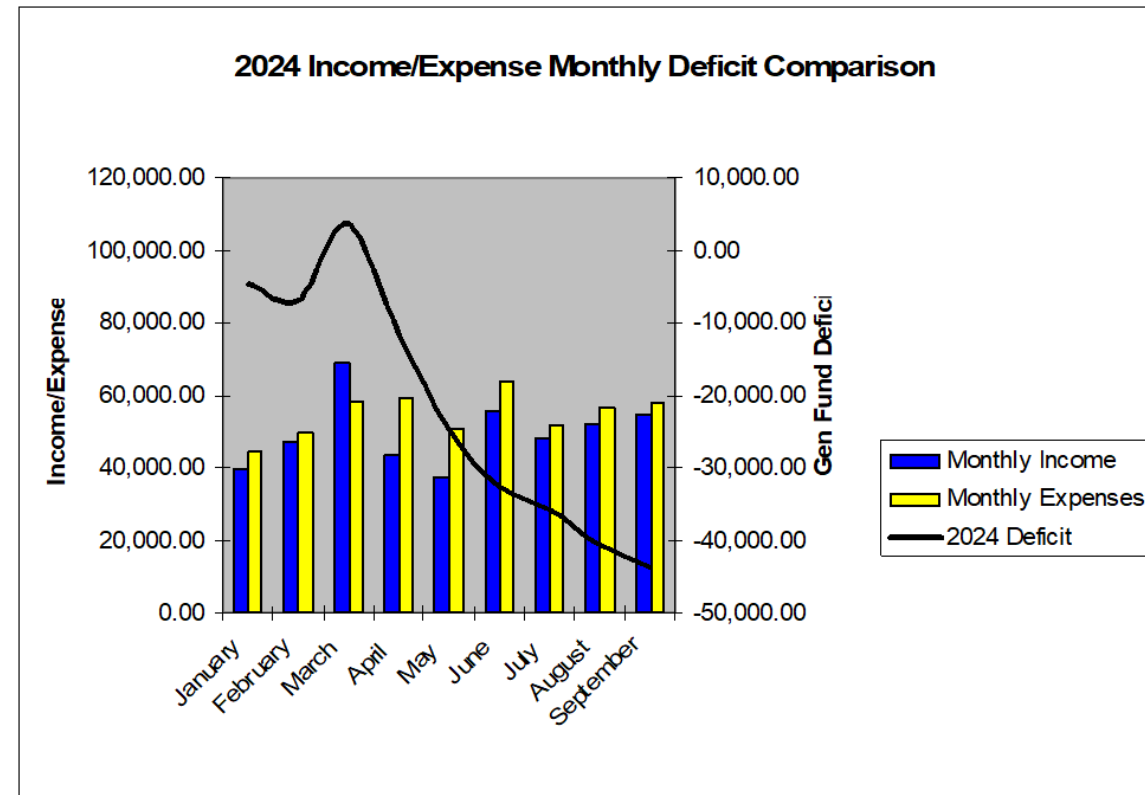


THE ANGEL TREE
