


WE NEED VOLUNTEERS!

(The negative-going black deficit line shows that we are behind budget and getting steadily more behind).

Sorry folks, but October was a bad month, just about the worst month of the whole year. Our contributions were \$10-15K lower than any of the last few months, increasing our deficit to \$59K (amount in the red) and decreasing our General Fund balance by \$15K. We have two months yet in 2024 to raise enough money to come out in the black for the year. Our people have always been very generous in their giving in the last two months of the year. Please pray fervently about stewardship in this last period of time. We don't want to start out the beginning of 2025 much in the red.
