

Thanks to God, we came out fairly well at the end of 2024. We didn't end up in the black, but we're not nearly as far in the red as I had feared earlier in the year. Largely thanks to Pr. Gueldner's stewardship sermons during the fall, your response to our plea for December contributions was encouraging. As good as November's donations were, December's contributions were even better. The last two months' income was enough to eliminate two-thirds of our deficit, leaving us with a \$19,220 deficit. Also our expenses were lower than expected during 2024, due to an easy winter and other reasons. At year's end, the General Fund was at \$112,481, a fairly healthy start to the new 2025 year.

Thanks to all of you who worked so hard and dug so deep to help us come out as well as we did in 2024. God bless you all! Now please continue giving at the same rate into 2025 so we may continue our stable finances into the next year.
