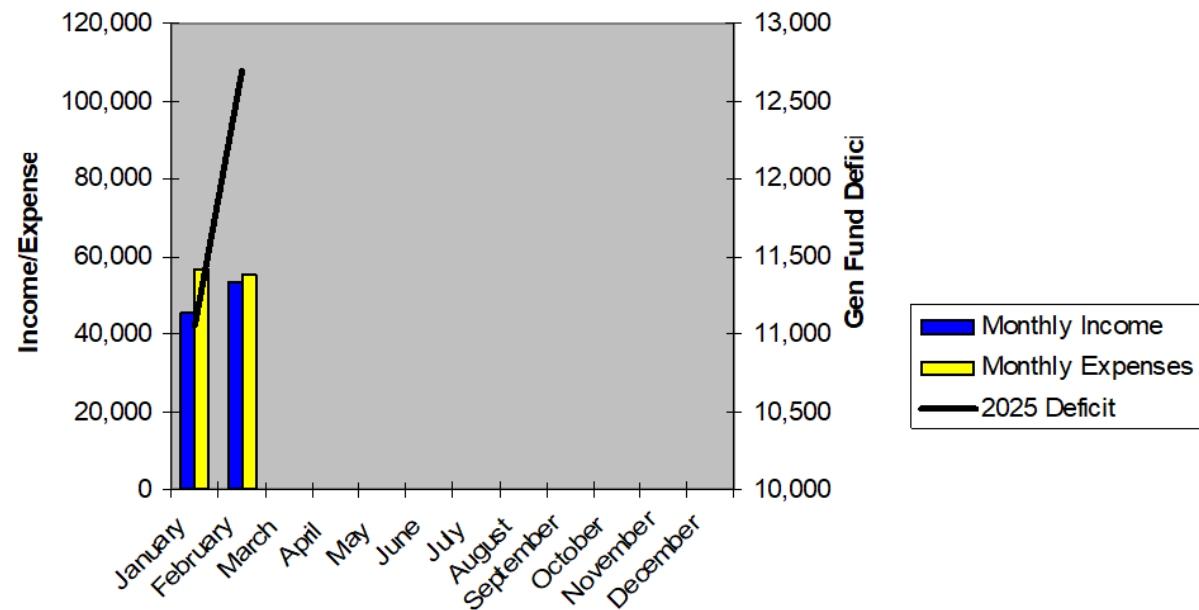

## 2025 Income/Expense Monthly Deficit Comparison



February Income: \$53,393.92    February Expenses: \$55,038.28    Monthly Budget: \$61,268.00

Deficit Increase during January and February: \$12,694.64. From now on, an upwards line means an increased deficit.

General Fund Balance as of 2/28/2025: \$100,020.74

The January income was about \$11,000 lower than the expenses. A big part of this difference was the inclement weather we had during one of the weeks.

February was much better causing only a \$1,700 deficit for that month. However, it was a good month largely because of a large donation from one of our members.
