Asia, ¹⁹serving the Lord with all
humility and with tears and with
trials that happened to me through
the plots of the Jews; ²⁰how I did
not shrink from declaring to you
anything that was profitable, and
teaching you in public and from
house to house, ²¹testifying both
to Jews and to Greeks of repent-
ance toward God and of faith in
our Lord Jesus Christ. ²²And now,

behold, I am going to Jerusalem,
constrained by the Spirit, not
knowing what will happen to me
there, ²³except that the Holy Spirit
testifies to me in every city that
imprisonment and afflictions
await me. ²⁴But I do not account
my life of any value nor as pre-
cious to myself, if only I may fin-
ish my course and the ministry

sus, to testify to the gospel of the
grace of God. ²⁵And now, behold,
I know that none of you among
whom I have gone about pro-
claiming the kingdom will see my
face again.

SECOND LESSON

⁹After this I looked, and behold, a great multitude that no one could number, from every nation, from all tribes and peoples and languages, standing before the throne and before the Lamb, clothed in white robes, with palm branches in their hands, ¹⁰and crying out with a loud voice, "Salvation belongs to our God who sits on the throne, and to the Lamb!" ¹¹And all the angels were standing around the throne and around the elders and the four living creatures, and they fell on their faces before the throne and worshiped God, ¹²saying, "Amen!
