

The vote for the consolidation took place on Monday, May 19. The vote results for Trinity were 94—YES to approve and proceed, 47— NO to not approve and not proceed. Sixty-six percent voted to proceed, but this was not enough to meet the required 75%.

Peace Lutheran also voted NO on proceeding with the consolidation.


Our first bike/walk will be June 8 at 2 p.m. at the Fleckenstein Bluffs Park at 691 1st Ave. NE. Faribault.


