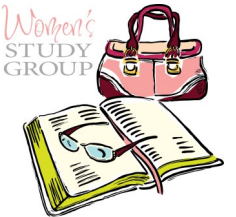
**6<sup>th</sup> grade instructor: Mrs. Nancy**

**23225 Glenview Trail**, a short way out of town, Bring a lawn chair, if you want, you may need to sit down.

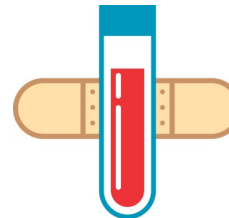
