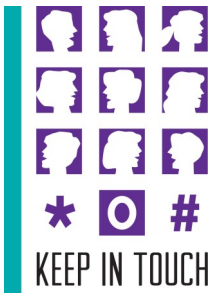

Fun for You—Starting Something New!

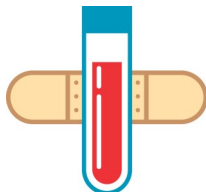

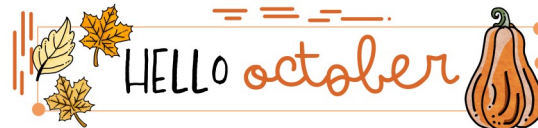
