A pie social will follow the service. All are welcome. If you'd like to bring a pie, that would be great! If you do bring a pie, please be sure to have it sliced and ready for serving.


Trinity will <u>NOT</u> be having separate Thanksgiving Eve or Day services this year. Please join us at Peace!
