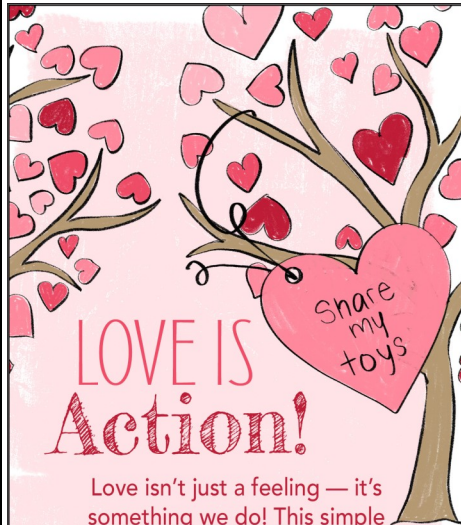

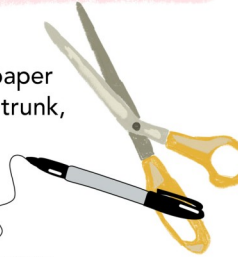


## LOVE IS Action!

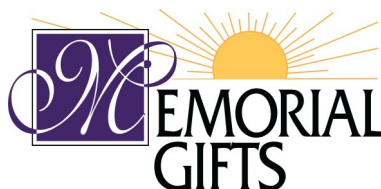

### **Faribault Lutheran School Report:**

**Rescheduled Christmas Service:** Due to the weather, the FLS Christmas service had to be rescheduled. The service will now be on Monday, January 12, in the FLS Gym. The service will be live-streamed.

**National Lutheran Schools Week:** NLSW will begin on Sunday, January 25, with a joint church service at Peace Lutheran Church at 9 AM. The week will be filled with dress-up days, all school devotions, all school projects, an all-school field trip, and kicking off our Kids for Heart Challenge! The week will wrap up with the highly anticipated Souper Bowl competition on Friday, January 30.

### **FOC report:**

December contributions exceeded expenses by \$16,166.46, similar to last year.

Year-end deficit to 2025 budget: \$105,258.49.

Year-end deficit to 2025 actual expenses: \$69,871.51.

We start 2026 with a general fund surplus of about \$48k, which is about \$64k less than last year.

District says they'll be reducing their contribution to Rev. Reat's ministry to \$5,000.

Noel has told them we'll be reducing our contribution to them by \$5,000 to \$54,000 for FY 2026.

There may be a possible need for all groups' finances to be listed in the budget.

### **Family Ministry:**

Our Sunday School Christmas service was held on Dec. 13 with Sunday School students in age 3 through grade 6 involved.

40 Goodie bags were donated and distributed. Nerf day is January 19 with a time for elementary kids and a time for the older youth. We are planning to have 5-6 confirmation class and Sunday School on January 25 at 9:15 for those students who are not involved in FLS.

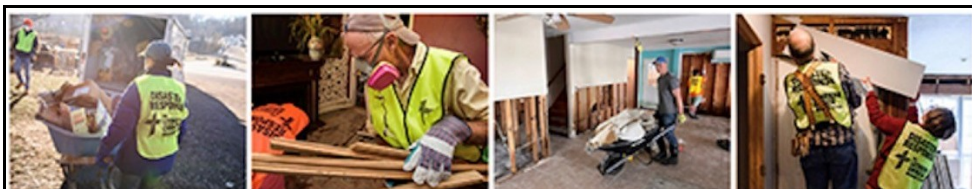

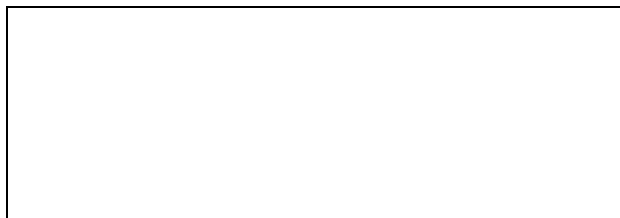
