### Peace Summer Care

Peace Preschool will offer summer care from June 1–August 7 and will be closed July 3 and 6; full tuition is charged for all ten weeks regardless of attendance, and a \$50 deposit (applied to your first payment) is required to hold a spot.

Weekly rates are \$190 for children entering kindergarten (fall 2026) through age 12, \$200 for children 33 months through prekindergarten, \$250 for toddler room (16–33 months), with children 33 months or older who are not potty trained charged the toddler rate; part-time care is \$50 per day and accepted only if space allows, with priority given to full-time students.

Each classroom requires a minimum of seven children to open, with priority for enrollment given to current students and siblings before opening to the public. If you would like a registration packet, please contact the FLS school office.
