
A Word: In Genesis 12, God makes a promise to Abraham. Abraham demonstrates his faith by leaving his former home for a land he had never seen. Faith is the foundation for all good works. We hear God's Word first, as did Abraham, and believing it, act on it. Paul makes a similar point in Romans 4. He argues that Abraham was not counted righteous because of his works, but because of his faith in God's promise. While works must follow faith, works do not justify, because faith always precedes them.

In John 3, Jesus points Nicodemus to the birth from above (the Greek word translated "again" in verse 3, also means "above"). The birth from above is spiritual birth into the kingdom of God. As Jesus clearly teaches, this birth is brought by water and the Spirit, that is, baptism. Baptism is the doorway of the church and entrance into God's kingdom.
