A Word: In our Old Testament reading, we see the faith of Israel fail almost immediately after leaving Egypt. Faced with adversity, they begin to question God's motive in rescuing them from slavery. Their story is a warning to us. Our faith must not depend on circumstances, but on the promise of salvation God makes to us in Jesus. Water appears again in John 4. But while the woman at the well seeks only physical water from Jesus, he identifies himself as the source of living water (the Spirit) who gives eternal life to all who believe in him.

Finally, in Romans 5, Paul reminds us that God uses our suffering to produce perseverance, character, and hope. The assurance of God working out salvation from adversity is Jesus Christ, whose death on the cross is proof of God's love for you and me. — *Pastor Alex*
