Hymn of the Day: Our hymn of the day for Trinity Sunday is, *Holy, Holy, Holy*. Throughout Scripture, God is praised with a threefold repetition of holy. Not only does this remind us of God's absolute perfection, but it also reminds us that we worship a triune God. Our God is three persons, Father, Son, and Holy Spirit, but only one God. As we sing this hymn, we witness all creation praising our God. We begin in the morning (verse 1), acknowledging God's mercy and might. We then move to the halls of heaven, where saints cast their golden crowns around God's throne. By verse 4, we acknowledge and participate in the praise of all creation in blessing our Triune God.

TRINITY SUNDAY

A Word: Today is Holy Trinity Sunday. At first, it may seem strange to have a Sunday dedicated to a specific doctrine. Most special Sundays are dedicated to an event, such as the birth of Jesus (Christmas), the crucifixion and resurrection (Holy Week and Easter), or the coming of the Spirit (Pentecost). But Trinity Sunday is different. It is a reminder to us of the absolute foundation of the Christian Church, which is the God we worship. Each of our readings presents to us the work of the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit, three persons, one God. Genesis 1 displays the work of the Trinity in creation. The Father working through the Word and the Spirit gives life. In Acts 2, the Father raises the Son and the Son pours out the Holy Spirit. And in Matthew 28, Jesus commands the Church to baptize in the name of the Father, Son and Holy Spirit. This is our great God, worthy of all praise, adoration, and thanksgiving.
