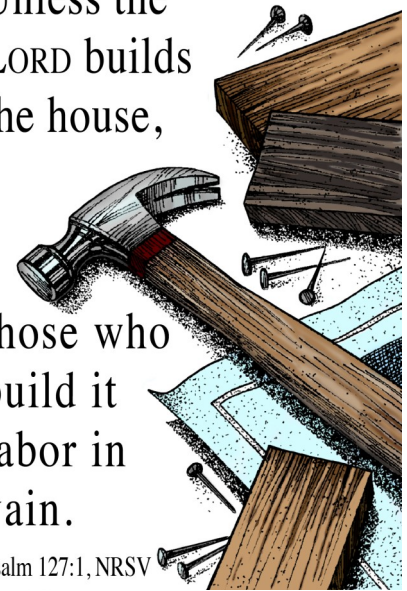

Confirmation May 10th at the 10:30 Service. Pictures at 9:15

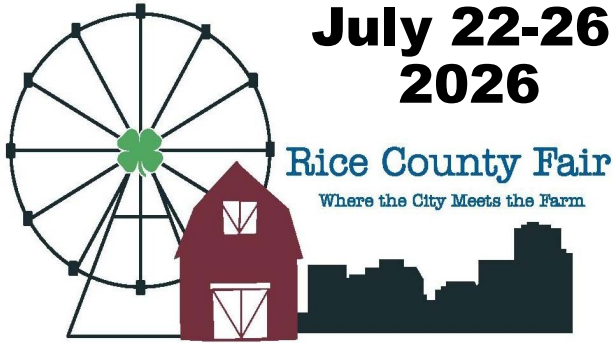

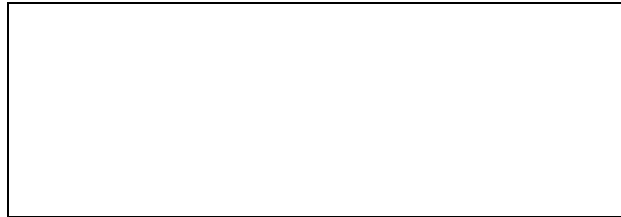

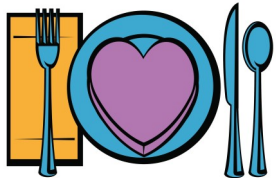
