Hymn of the Day: In "Come, Follow Me," *the Savior Spake*, we hear the same invitation that Jesus gave to Matthew in our Gospel reading. Verse 1 reminds us that the call to follow Christ is first a call to renunciation of the world and self-denial, or as we more often call these things, repentance. The next three verses describe who we are following. Jesus is our way to the Father, he is God's love for us, he is our teacher and refuge. Finally, verse 5 places Christian conviction on our lips as we sing, "Then let us follow Christ, our Lord, and take the cross appointed...For those who bear the battle's strain the crown of heav'nly life obtain."

A Word: In our Gospel reading, the Pharisees are offended because Jesus is eating with tax collectors and sinners. The problem, however, is not Jesus' eating, but the Pharisees' pride. They do not believe that they should be counted with the sinners that Jesus came to save. They are already righteous. But Jesus says to them, "I have not come to call the righteous, but sinners." If we want to hear Jesus' call to salvation, then we must do what the Pharisees refused, humbly admit that we are sinners and that we need the mercy Jesus came to give. Our Old Testament reading reminds us that mercy is what God desires. He doesn't want our stuff (sacrifice) but our repentance, so that he can show us mercy.

Our epistle reading defines how we are saved, not through works, but through faith. Paul proves this from the story of Abraham, who received the promise of a son from God. Abraham couldn't work to fulfill that promise because he was well past the age of having children, but he trusted God, and God kept his Word. The same is true for our salvation. We can't earn it with our works, but we trust God and he fulfills his Word. ~Pastor Alex
