**Hymn of the Day:** The sermon hymn is a reflection on the love of God for us in Jesus Christ. Because all of us have experienced love, we all have a definition for it. Love can be the emotion associated with family and friends. It is often thought of as a particularly close attachment to something. And of course, action accompanies love. But human love always stops short of the perfect love of God. We love those who love us and do good for those who do good for us. But the love of God surpasses ours in this: that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us (Romans 5:8). In *God Loved the World, so that He Gave*, not only is the love of God set before us, but so is its benefit. Christ died so that we might receive eternal life. No matter what is going on in your life, the perfect love of God in Christ is the sure foundation for your hope.

**A Word:** In our Old Testament reading, God reminds the people of Israel how he rescued them from Egypt and carried them on “eagles’ wings” to Mount Sinai (Exodus 19:4). At Sinai, God formally entered a covenant with Israel to take them as his own chosen people. This story should lead us to reflect on our own exodus from sin and death accomplished at baptism, where God adopts us as his own children through Jesus Christ.

In Matthew 9:36, we’re told that Jesus had compassion on the crowds because they were “harassed and helpless, like sheep without a shepherd.” Jesus is the shepherd God sent to bring us back home, even after we had blindly wandered away from him. Paul reflects on this same theme of God’s love for the lost when he writes in Romans 5:8, “God shows his love for us in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us.”
