Hymn of the Day: Our hymn of the day is *Let Us Ever Walk with Jesus*. No one said the Christian life would be easy, and anyone who told you that lied. Jesus himself says in Matthew 10:16, "I am sending you out as sheep in the midst of wolves." And as our hymn acknowledges, we pass through a world that would deceive us (v. 1), where we will suffer (v. 2), and where we will die (v. 3). But we follow Christ through all these things because the end is eternal life (v. 4). As Jesus reminds us in our Gospel reading, not one of us will fall to the ground apart from our Father's care.

A Word: In our Gospel reading, Jesus sends his disciples out as sheep in the midst of wolves. Jeremiah knew exactly what that was like, as he complains bitterly in our Old Testament reading of the painful trials that accompanied his ministry. But all who serve Christ are comforted by this promise from Christ, "Everyone who acknowledges me before men, I also will acknowledge before my Father in heaven." Confident in salvation, we continue steadfast in our faith despite all trouble.

Paul reminds us in Romans that even though we are saved by grace, we must not fall back into a life of sin. The way of salvation is the way of repentance and faith leading to eternal life, but the way of sin is slavery and death. Therefore, we must no longer present our bodies as instruments of unrighteousness, but we are to give ourselves to God as instruments of righteousness, gladly doing his will and looking forward to the gift of eternal life.
