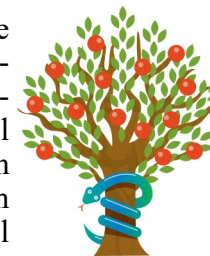

A Word: The First Commandment is: You shall have no other gods. This commandment defines the relationship the Creator of all things intends to have with us. We are to look to him alone as the source of all good things, our heavenly Father who gives, sustains, and protects our lives. Genesis 3 reminds us of the first sin. The Serpent succeeded in convincing Eve to eat the fruit by tempting her to doubt God's goodness. She broke the First Commandment in her heart because she desired to make herself like God instead of remaining content to receive all good things from God. Paul analyzes the effect of sin in Romans 1. All the terrible actions that come from sin flow from the same source. Humanity has turned away from God by suppressing the truth about God (verse 18). Finally, the thief on the cross shows us what it means to keep the First Commandment. He repents of his sin and turns to Jesus for mercy, receiving true life from Christ even as his mortal life is brought to an end.
